

## Dataset Number Settings

Number settings are used to generate sequential and consistent identification for each record for an object. Fuse allows admins to control the criteria for generating number settings based on several criteria.

### To create number settings, follow these steps:

- Login to Fuse using your admin credentials.
- Click on the data tab.
- Choose the dataset on which you want to create the number settings.
- Click on the forms and rules option. A side sheet will open.
- Click on Number Settings option.
- Click on the “New Number Settings” option. A side sheet will open.
- Enter the rule name
- Enter the details
- Enter the criteria fields to define the number settings
- Next, enter the field values.
- Enter the Field name
- Enter the start range
- Enter the end range
- Enter the length
- Enter the prefix
- Enter the suffix
- Enter the field to maintain generated number
- Once done, click on the save option to save the settings.
