

## User-defined rule

A User Defined Rule is used to configure custom rules on a field or set of fields that are not a part of the predefined rules in Fuse. User Defined Rules give administrators the capability to write their own validation code in JavaScript or generate a code by logic through the UI.

For example, when a *Project Start Date* field should have a date before the *Project End Date* field, a User Defined Rule can establish the check.

### To configure user-defined rule, follow these steps:

- Login to Fuse using your admin credentials.
- Go to the data tab.
- Select the dataset from the side menu for which the user defined rule needs to be configured.
- Click on the “Forms and Rules” option. A side-sheet will open.
- Click on the “business rules” option.
- Click on the new business rule option.
- Select user defined rules as the rule type.
- Enter the rule name or description.
- Enter the field you want to apply the UDR rule as per your business requirements.
- Select the operator from the dropdown.
- Select the comparison value from the dropdown.
- Select field(s) to display the error message.
- Enter the error message you want to display.
- Once done, click on the save option to save the rule.
- The newly created user-defined rule will be available in the business rules section.
