

Metadata Rule

The Metadata Rule is used in passive governance mode to compare the field values against the metadata properties. For example, it will check if the actual date is entered in the date type field or not. If a text is entered in the date type field, this rule will show an error.

To configure metadata rule, follow these steps:

- Login to Fuse using your admin credentials.
- Go to the data tab.
- Select the dataset from the side menu for which the metadata rule needs to be configured.
- Click on the “Forms and Rules” option. A side-sheet will open.
- Click on the “business rules” option.
- Click on the new business rule option.
- Select metadata rule as the rule type.
- Enter the rule category from the dropdown
- Enter the rule name or description
- Enter the field. Users can enter one or multiple fields as per their requirement.
- Once done, click on the save option to save the rule.
- Enter the error message to display when the rule is not met

The newly created metadata rule will be available in the business rules section.
